## **GMHOTS Questions**

- 1. List down 10 herbal plants used as natural medicine. Write details about anyone of them including its origin, scientific name, its use, side effects, benefits and any interesting fact.
- 2. Prepare a report about one famous mathematician. How is his/her formula useful to us?
- 3. Find out different types of tribes in different continents. List down 10 such tribes and give brief details about one tribe.
- 4. Make a survey in your family or in your neighborhood and find how many are using spectacles. Make a report about their age group, brand, power, usage, type of lens, etc. Make your observation and provide tips to take care of eyes.
- 5. Write briefly about the biography of any one famous personality with some pictures. Give your reasons for choosing him/her.
- 6. Prepare your own crossword puzzle (max 20) by using mathematical terms.
- 7. Find and write about ten Nobel prize winners (one each in different categories). Give reasons for each person why you have chosen and included in your list?
